

Report on Training Session: Understanding Citation Methods

Introduction:

On June 11th, 2019, Saffrony Institute organized a training session aimed at enhancing students' understanding of citation methods such as IEEE, APA, MLA, Chicago, etc., and how to implement them correctly in their academic papers to maintain academic integrity.
