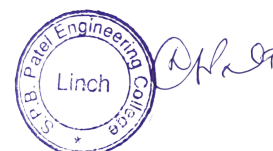

Holistic Approach to Student Development:

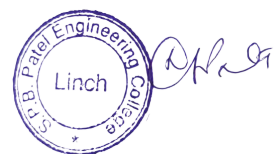





DATE: February 11, 2022

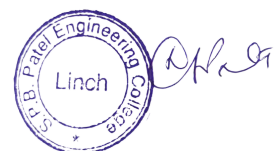
Program Overview:

Engagement Highlights:

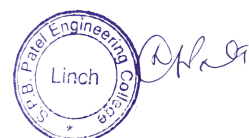



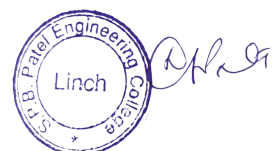

5. Expert Speaker: Ms. Nishma Shah:

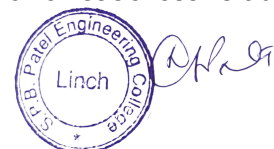

7. Session Conclusion:

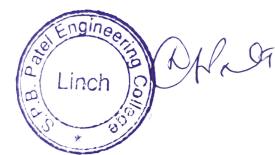

- Pictures depicted various acts such as helping a fellow student, assisting faculty members, and spreading smiles in the community.

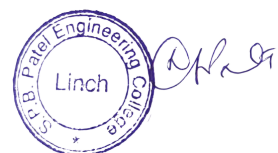

Objective:

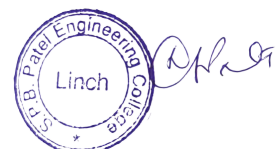

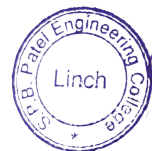
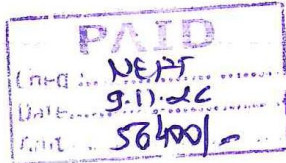
